

 Parallel Thimble Shoal Tunnel As part of a joint venture, we are the lead designer for a major design-build project that will create a new bored tunnel between two artificial portal islands in Chesapeake Bay.

2. Regional Connector

Los Angeles Metro's Regional Connector, now in the construction phase, will provide a seamless link for rides throughout Los Angeles County.

3. JFK International Airport Master Plan This major project will enable JFK to recapture its position as one of the world's great airports.

4. Block Island Wind Farm

The success of this offshore wind farm project has set in motion the development of a further 300 megawatts of wind capacity off the coast of Rhode Island, and the potential of many more gigawatts of US offshore wind projects.

5. Liberty Island Water and Wastewater Upgrade

Mott MacDonald designed a solution that used pipebursting and horizontal directional drilling to protect buildings, utilities, and historic sea walls while limiting disruption to visitors and staff.

6. Arbutus Greenway Project

Our planning and design work is setting the stage for Vancouver's vision of blending facilities for bicycles, pedestrians, and a future streetcar with spaces for urban agriculture, public art, infill development, and community events.

7. PennEast Pipeline

We are providing engineering, procurement, and construction management (EPCM) services for a 120-mile, 36-inch natural gas pipeline, bringing clean-burning natural gas to the northeastern US.

8. Mobile River Bridge

As Project Manager and Owner's Representative, we are overseeing all aspects of the state's first public-private partnership project, which will replace the existing Bayway Bridges with a new 1,250foot six-lane cable-stayed bridge across the Mobile River.

9. Silicon Valley BART Extension to Berryessa

Extending service from Warm Springs to northern San Jose, this project positions us for the next extension of the Bay Area Rapid Transit system.

10. Carlsbad Desalination Plant

Our technical advisory services helped create the largest desalination plant in the Western Hemisphere, producing an average of 50 million gallons (189 million liters) per day of fresh, high-quality drinking water.
